

TRANSMITTAL OF THE D2/R1 FISCAL YEAR 2011 SITE MANAGEMENT PLAN, PADUCAH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT, PADUCAH, KENTUCKY

Please find enclosed the certified D2/R1 *Site Management Plan, Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, Paducah, Kentucky*, Annual Revision FY 2011, DOE/LX/07-0348&D2/R1, (SMP). The enclosed D2/R1 SMP incorporates the conditions set forth in the conditional concurrence received from the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection (KDEP) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on April 25, 2011, and April 26, 2011, respectively. The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) would like to note that it has worked closely with EPA and KDEP over the last six months to obtain an approvable D2 SMP and was disappointed that we received conditional concurrence. 
