WASTE AREA GROUPING 23 PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN, PADUCAH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT, PADUCAH, KENTUCKY, RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY ACT PERMIT NUMBER KY8-890-008-982 (DOE/OR/07-1771&D2)

As discussed during the November 8-9, 1999, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Kentucky, and Department of Energy Senior Management Meeting in Paducah, DOE is hereby officially requesting the withdrawal of the subject document from the regulatory review process.
