REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION TO APPENDIX C AND APPENDIX G OF THE FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT FOR SUBMITTAL DATES OF THE D1 RECORD OF DECISION AND OTHER DECISION DOCUMENTS FOR THE GROUNDWATER OPERABLE UNIT RECORD OF DECISION 1, C-720 AREA, PADUCAH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT, PADUCAH, KENTUCKY

This letter requests a modification of the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) deliverable date for the submittal of the Groundwater Operable Unit (GWOU) Record of Decision (ROD) 1 from November 21, 2001, to January 17, 2002, and other decision documents, in accordance with FFA Section XXIX.

On November 9, 2001, the Department of Energy (DOE) submitted an extension request, with good cause, proposing that each of the six GWOU ROD 1 milestone dates be extended approximately six weeks. The Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection (KDEP) replied on December 3, 2001, and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region IV, replied on December 14, 2001, denying DOE this extension. DOE responded on December 20, 2001, with an invocation of informal dispute. On January 11, 2002, a GWOU Core Team teleconference was conducted to resolve the informal dispute. DOE, KDEP, and EPA agreed to accept the extension of the proposed dates with the exception of the ROD signature date. The

ROD signature date will remain as April 23, 2002. Proposed dates for the other decision documents and remedial action field mobilization are provided on the enclosed modification forms. At the end of this meeting, the informal dispute was resolved by consensus from DOE, EPA, and KDEP. DOE also agreed to provide EPA and KDEP with the milestone dates for the field-start of the C-720 and Solid Waste Management Unit 1 remedial actions in fiscal year 2004.

The enclosed modification forms, prepared in accordance with Section XXXIX of the FFA, reflect changes to enforceable milestone dates for the D1 ROD 1 submittal and for other affected documents. Please execute the forms and return them to DOE for inclusion in the Administrative Record File.
