Task Order DE-DT000774: Fluor Federal Services, Inc., Paducah Deactivation Project—Deliverable No. 101.31—2016 Treatability Study Summary Report

Fluor Federal Services, Inc., Paducah Deactivation Project (FPDP) has reviewed the requirements associated with the treatability study summary report. In accordance with 401 *KAR* 31:010 § 4 [40 *CFR* § 261.4(f)(9)], the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection requires annual submittal of a treatability study summary report for treatability studies that were conducted during the previous calendar year (CY). These studies typically are required for wastes that do not have an identified disposition path.

No treatability studies were conducted during CY 2016. Based on this, a treatability study summary report is not required this year. No additional action is needed with respect to regulatory requirements.

Additionally, FPDP does not anticipate conducting any treatability studies in CY 2017; however, if the determination is made that a treatability study is required, a 45-day advance notification to the regulators will be submitted, as required under 401 *KAR* 31:010 § 4 [40 *CFR* § 261.4(f)(1)].
